Subject: TISPC Legislative Update

The General Assembly reconvened Tuesday, August 22nd, for their second special session since the long session ended on June 30th. It is anticipated that on Thursday they will vote to override vetoes on five bills. There will also be votes on the new legislative redistricting maps on Friday and Monday.

What still remains to be seen are the several bills that are eligible for consideration which may pop up next week. One eligible bill is HB56, an omnibus, regulatory reform bill, which has a provision that would set up a storm water mitigation fund for the coast. No money would be appropriated and at this point there is a prohibition for state monies to be used for a hardened structure.
